





In Thy kingdom remember us, O Lord, when Thou comest in Thyking - dom.




1. Blessed are the poor in spir - it, for theirs is the kingdom of heav - en.




2. Bless - ed are those who\_ mourn, for they shall be com - fort - ed.

5. Blessed are the mer - ci - ful, for they shall obtain mer - cy.




6. Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.
